

# Class Descriptions

**Good News**-To help children gain a deeper understanding of the events of Holy Week, they will work together to create a "Good News" book. Creation of the book will include learning key scripture from Matthew and vocabulary, designing a cover, creating an index page, drawing pictures and a map of Jerusalem, writing poems, and more!

**Apostle's Playhouse**-Children will discover their inner actor as they learn about the events of Holy Week by listening and acting out scenes from Jesus' and the apostles' lives from the time they enter Jerusalem on Monday through Jesus' arrest in the Garden of Gethsemane. Children will take photographs of the "scenes" they create.

**Hollywood**-Children will have fun eating popcorn and watching a video about the Easter story and make a cross.

**Creation Station**-Children will create art depicting Jerusalem at the time Jesus lived, taught and died. They will understand the layout of Jerusalem and the routes Jesus traveled during the last week of His life. Children will follow the events of Holy Week and illustrate some of them on a map.

**Antioch Arcade**-Children will play a "life-sized" board game designed to help children become familiar with the main events of Holy Week and their sequence based on the account from Matthew.
